PRESIDING BISHOP

Timothy D. Coalter accepted Christ at a young age and became a licensed minister in the Church of God of Prophecy in 1979. That same year, he and his wife, Kelly, began ministry together as national evangelists. Over the next several decades, he served in youth ministry, pastoral leadership in multiple states, and as state bishop of South Carolina before being selected in 2014 as North America general presbyter for Canada and the United States. In 2022, Bishop Coalter was chosen to serve as presiding bishop at the 101st International Assembly. He has also served on numerous international boards and committees, including leadership roles with the Tomlinson Center, the Assembly Committee for Finance and Stewardship, and the corporate boards of both the International Offices and Spirit and Life Seminary. Bishop Coalter has also served with the Pentecostal/Charismatic Churches of North America. He earned a Master of Arts in Church Ministries from Pentecostal Theological Seminary and currently resides in Cleveland, Tennessee. He shared 45 years of marriage with his beloved wife, Kelly, before her passing in 2025. They are blessed with three children and eight grandchildren.

PASTOR AND PROFESSOR
DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Cesarina Flores has served as pastor of the Church of God of Prophecy in Punta Cana since 2015, leading ministries focused on leadership development, stewardship, and holistic care. At the national level, Dr. Flores serves on the National Finance Committee and as National Stewardship Ministry leader for the Church of God of Prophecy in the Dominican Republic. She also teaches for Spirit and Life Seminary, facilitates graduate programs at Universidad Abierta para Adultos, and mentors doctoral students in ministry studies. In addition to her pastoral ministry, Dr. Flores is a dentist with a degree in psychology and advanced degrees in family therapy, religion, neuroscience, crisis intervention, grief, and post-traumatic stress. She earned a Doctor of Ministry degree from Western Theological Seminary and integrates clinical, psychological, and theological training into her ministry and academic work. She and her husband, Alexander Castro, have been married for 24 years and are the parents of Axel and Gabriel.

Tim Harper serves as regional bishop for the Church of God of Prophecy's Great Lakes Ministries, overseeing Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, and Wisconsin since 2004. He and his wife, Karen, are the parents of Brittany, Chandler, and Stetson and his wife, Miranda, and grandparents of Grace Willow and Judah James. Called to ministry as a teenager, Dr. Harper has served the church in pastoral, youth, and leadership roles for decades, including work on the Biblical Doctrine and Polity Committee, the International Leadership Development Team, and several international boards and task forces. He holds five graduate degrees, including a PhD in World Religions with a concentration in Islamic Studies and a Doctor of Ministry in Transformational Leadership. A licensed psychotherapist and nationally certified Healthy Congregations facilitator, Dr. Harper has spoken internationally on leadership, counseling, theology, and ministry. Dr. Harper also serves as a part-time professor at both Lee University and Spirit and Life Seminary, teaching theology, biblical studies, pastoral ministry, counseling, and church history. He is the author of several published articles, and his forthcoming book, *A. J. Tomlinson's Contribution to Classical Pentecostalism*, is scheduled for release in 2026.

Clayton Norris Martin was born in Jamaica and became a Christian and member of the Church of God of Prophecy in 1972. A graduate of Mico Teachers College, he met and married Sonia Foster, who continues to serve alongside him in ministry. In 1987, Bishop Martin was appointed pastor in George Town, where he led the church through significant spiritual and numerical growth. In 1998, he became national overseer for Jamaica, the Cayman Islands, Guyana, and French Guiana. Since 2010, he has served as general presbyter for the Caribbean and Atlantic Ocean Islands. Bishop Martin earned both a Master of Arts in Religion and a Doctor of Ministry degree from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary. Alongside his wife, Sonia, he travels extensively to preach, teach, supervise, and encourage churches throughout the region. He also serves in several civic and ministry leadership roles in the Cayman Islands, including with the Cayman Ministers' Association and the Center for Theological Leadership Training.

ASIA, AUSTRALIA, AND OCEANIA
GENERAL PRESBYTER

Tim McCaleb has served as general presbyter for the Asia, Australia, and Oceania regions of the Church of God of Prophecy since 2016. Licensed in ministry in 1980 and ordained as a bishop in 1989, he has served for decades in pastoral and leadership roles, including state youth director, regional overseer, state bishop in multiple regions, and member of the Biblical Doctrine and Polity Committee. Bishop McCaleb also led rebuilding efforts in earthquake-devastated Haiti, overseeing the reconstruction of churches, pastors' homes, and an orphanage, and also participated in construction ministry throughout Latin America, the Caribbean, and Africa. He holds degrees from University of Tennessee, Pentecostal Theological Seminary, Vanderbilt University, and Houston Graduate School of Theology. He and his wife, Sheena, have been married for 46 years and are blessed with four children and eleven grandchildren.

In 2022, he was appointed state bishop of Alabama, where the ministry has experienced growth through new church plants and new missions, a new state office in Huntsville, and the construction of a new chapel at Camp Boothe. Dr. Ramsey earned a Master of Education in Counseling and Human Development from Lindsey Wilson University and a Doctor of Ministry degree in Counseling from Pentecostal Theological Seminary. He is also a licensed professional clinical counselor in Kentucky. He and his wife, Kim, have three adult daughters, one teenage son, and several grandchildren.

Bishop J. Drew Sheard

PRESIDING BISHOP
CHURCH OF GOD IN CHRIST

J. Drew Sheard is the presiding bishop and chief apostle of the worldwide Church of God in Christ. Born in Detroit, he answered the call to ministry at a young age and began his pastoral ministry at Great Emmanuel Church in 1988. Bishop Sheard earned degrees in education and mathematics from Wayne State University and has served his church in numerous national leadership roles, including International Youth Department president and chairman of the AIM Convention. In 2010, he was elevated to the office of jurisdictional bishop, and in 2021, he was elected presiding bishop of the denomination. Alongside his wife, Karen Clark Sheard, he co-founded Karew Records, a faith-based music label focused on gospel and inspirational music. Bishop Sheard has also led major humanitarian and community initiatives, including disaster relief support for pastors, COVID-19 assistance efforts, workforce partnerships for formerly incarcerated individuals, and foster care housing initiatives in Tennessee. Under his leadership, the denomination eliminated its entire debt in 2023. Bishop Sheard and Lady Karen Clark-Sheard are the parents of Kierra Sheard and John Drew Sheard II, and grandparents of three grandchildren.
